JERUSALEM, JANUARY 21 – JANUARY 29

Theme : Reconciliation – The Love of Christ compels us

(cf. 2 Corinthians 5:14-20)

This biblical text emphasizes that reconciliation is a gift from God, intended for the entire creation. As a result of God's action, the person who has been reconciled in Christ is called in turn to proclaim this reconciliation in word and deed. Churches need the gift of God's reconciliation as a wellspring of life. But above all, they need it for their common witness to the world: "that they all may be one, Father, just as you are in me and I in you. May they also be in us that the world may believe that you have sent me" (John 17:21)." The world needs ministers of reconciliation, who will break down barriers, build bridges, make peace.
